
The city's older part is separated from the newer part by a small garden. Malta's perhaps most beauiful church, St Helen Basilica can also be found in this town.





- A good level of English, equivalent to a 6 on the IELTS is required, OR OET with a minimum grade of 'B' on speaking or at least 'C+' in writing, reading, or listening. This requirement does not apply to students from English-speaking countries or those who completed their first degree in English.






Cancellation after arrival
